The Women's Media Group, a New York City-based, non-profit organization, is offering several internships during the summer of 2008 for minority women who are presently juniors in college. These paid positions are eight to ten weeks in length. The internships will be with national magazines, book publishers and other book-industry businesses, and broadcast networks. (Last year, we placed interns with HBO, Condé Nast, Bloomberg Radio, ABC, and Random House, among others.)

Housing is not provided and all applicants must be able to secure their own accommodations in the New York City area.

All interested applicants should contact us by e-mail no later than **Friday, February 15**. We will conduct interviews over the phone or in person during the months of January and February. Applicants will be informed of decisions on a rolling basis. Your application should include a resume and a detailed cover letter telling us about yourself, your college studies, GPA, and why you are interested in an internship in book publishing, magazine publishing, or broadcast media. Please note that your cover letter should address one of these areas specifically—a general interest in “media” is not sufficient for consideration.
